# **Service Animal Policy**

Only service dogs are allowed inside venues on Stampede Park. **Pets and emotional** support animals are not permitted, as they are not recognized under Alberta law.

## **Identification**

To enter, handlers must show an Alberta Service Dog Identification Card. This card verifies public access rights and includes:

- Alberta government logo
- · Picture of the service dog and handler

## **Service Dog Requirements**

#### Service dogs must:

- Be trained by an accredited organization (like ADI) or a qualified school.
- Have a training ID from the Government of Alberta Service ID card program.
- Wear a service animal vest and harness.

#### **Verification Process**

When entering, Guest Ambassadors will check for service dog identification. Once verified, handlers will receive a signed card to show others that their service animal is approved. This helps reduce repeated checks by other staff members in the building.



### Service dogs must be leashed and/or always harnessed:

- If a dog is disruptive or aggressive, the owner may be asked to leave Stampede property
- Denying Access: It is an offence to deny access to individuals with qualified service dogs, with fines up to \$3,000.
- False Claims: Falsely claiming a disability for pet access can lead to fines of up to \$300.
