

Safety Regulations for the 2026 Edmonton Boat and Sportsmen's Show Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) bulletin on Prime Contractor

- I will clearly indicate who the "Prime" contractor is if asked by OHS
- I will have completed a workplace hazard assessment while working during set up and tear down at the event
- I will ensure that any workers within my booth space working over 3 feet will have appropriate safety restraints
- I will only operate power tools with the appropriate safety guards

DOES YOUR BOOTH HAVE:	IF YES:
Drapes (not provided by the show): fabric panels on the sides, top or across/above the booth space excess of 50% coverage of the booth	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Must be fire retardant- Must not be in contact with a direct heat source (e.g. non-LED lighting)- Must have documentation available
Trailers/Campers/RV's: Any closed space surrounded by hard walls with roof	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Must have functional smoke detector installed inside- Must have fire extinguisher present
Cooking:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- No grease laden vapors (oil, greats, fats or butter)- For commercial use only- Must have fire extinguisher present
Demonstration cookware:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Cannot use grease laden vapors- Must have fire extinguisher present
Display Vehicles or Motorized Equipment:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- MUST have show management approval prior to arriving on site- Must have no more than ¼ tank of fuel OR no more than 20L, whichever is less- Gas tanks must be locked or sealed- Vehicles with over 9.3m² of roofed area only - Must have an active smoke detector and fire extinguisher 2A10BC- No propane is allowed in the unit or in the building
Motorcycles:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Must have no more than ¼ tank of fuel- Must have show management approval prior to arriving on site

(Motorcycles cont.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Must have fire extinguisher(s) - Must have spill kit(s) - Any refueling must be outside
Candles and open flame:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Must have a one-inch barrier around and above any flame
Propane:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Must be stored outside
Fresh cut trees:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Can only be used for display within 14 days of being cut - Must have fire retardant tag with proof of cut date - Must be kept watered
Animals:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ALL animals must have pre-approval from show management before entering the building - The show may be restricted by the venue and animals may not be allowed in the building at all, please ensure you have a conversation with show management prior to the show.
