## DISPLAY GARDENS Subsidy and Responsibilities

### Responsibilities of Show Include:

- Cash payment determined by garden size or location.
- Partial payment of subsidy mailed to Garden Creators in December 2026, and balance by April 2027.
- \$1000 credit for forced color or other colorful plant material at T & L Nursery, Redmond WA.
- Floor space at the Show, including access to water.
- Fill material (sawdust) and mulch for top dressing, provided by Pacific Topsoils.
- Availability of concrete products from Mutual Materials Co.
- Forklifts and bobcats with operators.
- 5 amps of electricity (additional amperage available at Garden Creators expense).
- Signage with name of Garden Creator.
- Overhead theatrical lighting.
- Publicity support by the Show's Public Relations firm.
- Publicity on the Show website and links to Garden Creator's website.
- Badges allowing free Show entry for employees to staff your garden.
- Complimentary Northwest Flower & Garden Festival tickets (two per 25 sq. ft.).

### The Garden Creator's Responsibilities Include:

- Design of the Garden, subject to the Show's approval.
- All materials necessary for the garden installation including, but not limited to, plants and hardscape materials, art, sculpture, furniture, ground lighting and accessories.
- Transportation, unloading and building of all Garden elements during assigned move-in times.
- The garden must be completed by noon, Tuesday, February 16, 2027.
- Complete removal of all Garden elements during assigned move-out time, to be completed by noon, February 23, 2027.
- Signs identifying featured plant material.
- Any literature you choose to hand out describing your company or group and the Garden.
- Carry Workers Compensation Insurance as required by law for your company and employees.
- Carry Commercial General Liability Insurance, and list Marketplace Events as additional insured. Garden Creator agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Show Management, the Seattle Convention Center, and their employees from any damage or losses arising out of or resulting from participation in the NWFGS, the Display Garden and activities of the Garden Creator, their employees, contracted agents, guests, invitees, or visitors.
