Food Vendors at the Minneapolis Home + Remodeling Show MUST:

Select one of the short-term food permit processes below:

- 1) If you already have a Seasonal or Mobile Food Permit or are a registered Cottage Food vendor– please send a copy of that document to Autumn Pennington (AutumnP@MPEShows.com) no later than Friday, January 12, 2024.
- 2) All other vendors will need to obtain a **Short-Term Permit** – review the city of Minneapolis guidelines here:

Beginning December 2023, the Minneapolis Environmental Health Department is now using an Online Form via *Smartsheet*. Each food and beverage vendor who is booked into the Minneapolis Home + Remodeling Show will be emailed a link to the Smartsheet form. This form will work on any device, and when submitted, will automatically be delivered directly to the health department agents reviewing the permits. The online forms are due directly to the health department no later than January 19, 2024 to avoid additional fees.
