

## Moncton Coliseum Welcomed Record Breaking Trade Event

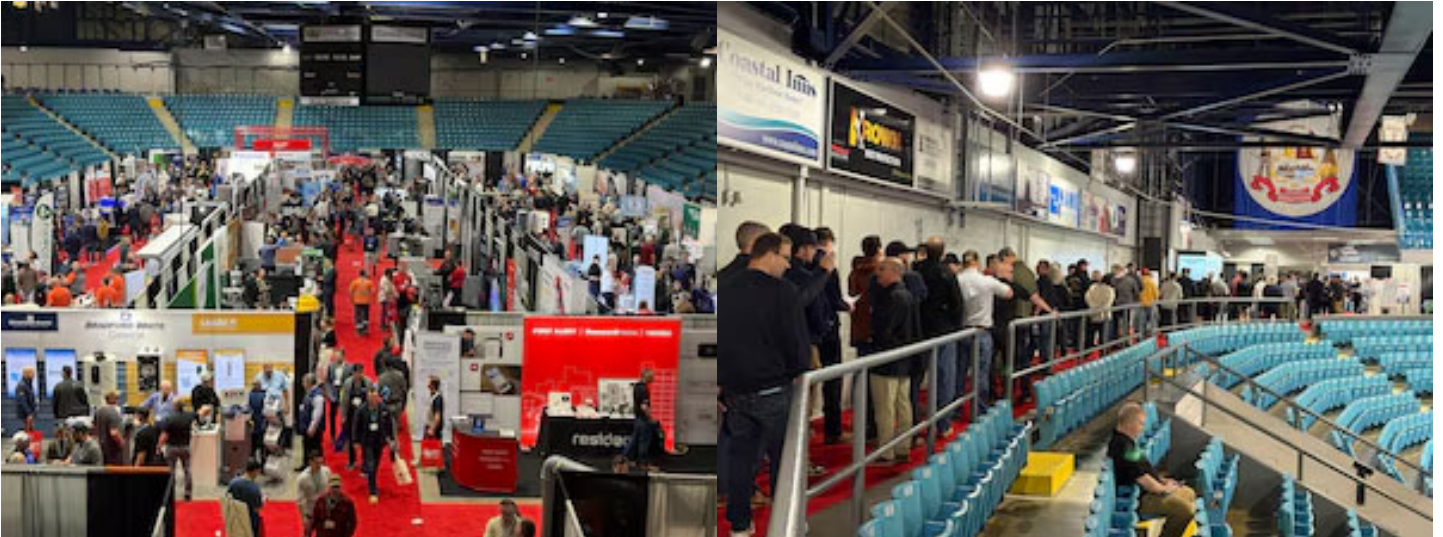
