

## 2026 Northwest Sportshow Food/Beverage Policies and Procedures

## SHORT TERM FOOD PERMIT INFORMATION AND APPLICATION

- Exhibitors who wish to sell or sample any food and/or beverage items at the show must follow the procedures outlined below, including a short-term permit or applicable license exception, plus all rules and required forms provided by the Minneapolis Convention Center (MCC)
- Applications or licenses are due by **February 12**, **2026**, to allow time for processing. There is a short period allowed for late applications at double the fee but must be discussed prior to booking.

EXCEPTION: If you already have a Seasonal or Mobile Food Permit or are a registered Cottage Food vendor–please send a copy of that document to Autumn Pennington (<u>AutumnP@MPEShows.com</u>) no later than Friday, February 12, 2026. Note that Food Trucks MUST be DBE-Approved by the Minneapolis Convention Center to participate.
